Clinician-Research Scholar

I am a clinician scientist, clinical and health services researcher, and pediatric nephrologist with extensive experience with collaborative multi-centered studies and big data research. My research agenda focuses on ensuring that proven medical care and ongoing discovery is optimally delivered to patients with kidney disease. My work has furthered our knowledge of the morbidity and mortality of children and young adults with end-stage kidney disease and spurred incorporation of under-utilized data resources to better evaluate the health and health services provided to children with kidney disease. I have made substantive contributions to multiple on-going funded studies including the NIH-funded Chronic Kidney Disease in Children longitudinal cohort study, the PCORI funded Preserving Kidney Function in Children with Chronic Kidney Disease study, Cure-GN, and Center for Disease Control and Prevention Chronic Kidney Disease Surveillance Project. Additionally, I lead the Kidney Research Network (KRN), a multicenter electronic health registry focused exclusively on children and adults with kidney disease, as Principle Investigator of the KRN Data Analysis and Clinical Coordinating Center. In this position, I and my team have the expertise, capabilities, and resources make a substantial contribution to the future of data collection in cohort studies and electronic health record research. As Director of the University of Michigan Pediatric Nephrology Research Program and faculty investigator at the Susan B. Meister Child Health Evaluation and Research (CHEAR) Center, I lead and facilitate multidisciplinary and multi-institutional research teams and execute study aims using electronic health record, digital health, observational studies, and claims data. I oversee a team of 12 and staff which include two program managers, four statisticians, a data architect, four research coordinators, and an administrative assistant with experience and expertise in executing research aims for funded studies. My team also has expertise in research regulatory affairs and provides regulatory oversight of single and multi-institutional pediatric and adult human subjects research.
